Would you like that for here, or to-go? This year you can choose to attend the in-person gingerbread workshop or take the magic home in one of our gingerbread kits!

The library's annual "Gingerbread Workshop" has been a popular family activity for more than a dozen years. Like everything else, it had to be reimagined back in 2020, and this year it was time to re-think it again. We asked what you wanted, and the survey results were clear. The take-home kits are here to stay, and it's time to add back an in-person option as well!

The in-person event is scheduled for Saturday, December 10, from 11am to 2pm. Drop in at your convenience to build a beautiful, edible holiday decoration from graham crackers, frosting, and a huge variety of candies and other food items. We supply everything but the imagination! There is no registration to attend, and you will NOT need to reserve a kit if you are coming to this event.

Take-home kits must be reserved in advance for pick-up the week of December 5. We'll be carefully packing 200 of them in the next few weeks. In order to share the fun with as many families as possible, the kits will be limited to ONE PER FAMILY. Each bag will have enough supplies to make 2 to 3 houses; larger families might want to supplement their kit with some extra graham crackers and maybe a little candy.

The reservation form for take home kits opens at 10am on Monday, November 28 and is likely to fill up fast.
